







### Coursework & Standards: R.O.S.E.®Graduates Despite Previously NOT Passing High-Stakes Exam




### Career Transition: 2010 Graduates Rate by Cohort

#### AZ Designation for AECs

- Mission statement or charter expressly identifies benefits of alternative school setting to specific student population
- Educational program & related student services must match the mission or charter
- Must offer a diploma of high school graduation

#### Students Served

- Students with behavioral issues (documented history of disruptive behavior)
- Students identified as dropouts
- Students in poor academic standing
- Pregnant and/or parenting students
- Adjudicated youth


